FISCAL RECOVERY FUND PROJECT AND EXPENDITURE REPORTS ARE DUE TO TREASURY BY APRIL 30

All counties must submit a Project and Expenditure Report to the U.S. Treasury Department by April 30, 2022.

- For counties that have a population of more than 250,000 or that received more than \$10 million in fiscal recovery funds, this will be the second quarterly report, covering the period from Jan. 1, 2022 to March 31, 2022.
- For all other counties, this will be the first annual report, covering the period from March 3, 2021 to March 31, 2022.

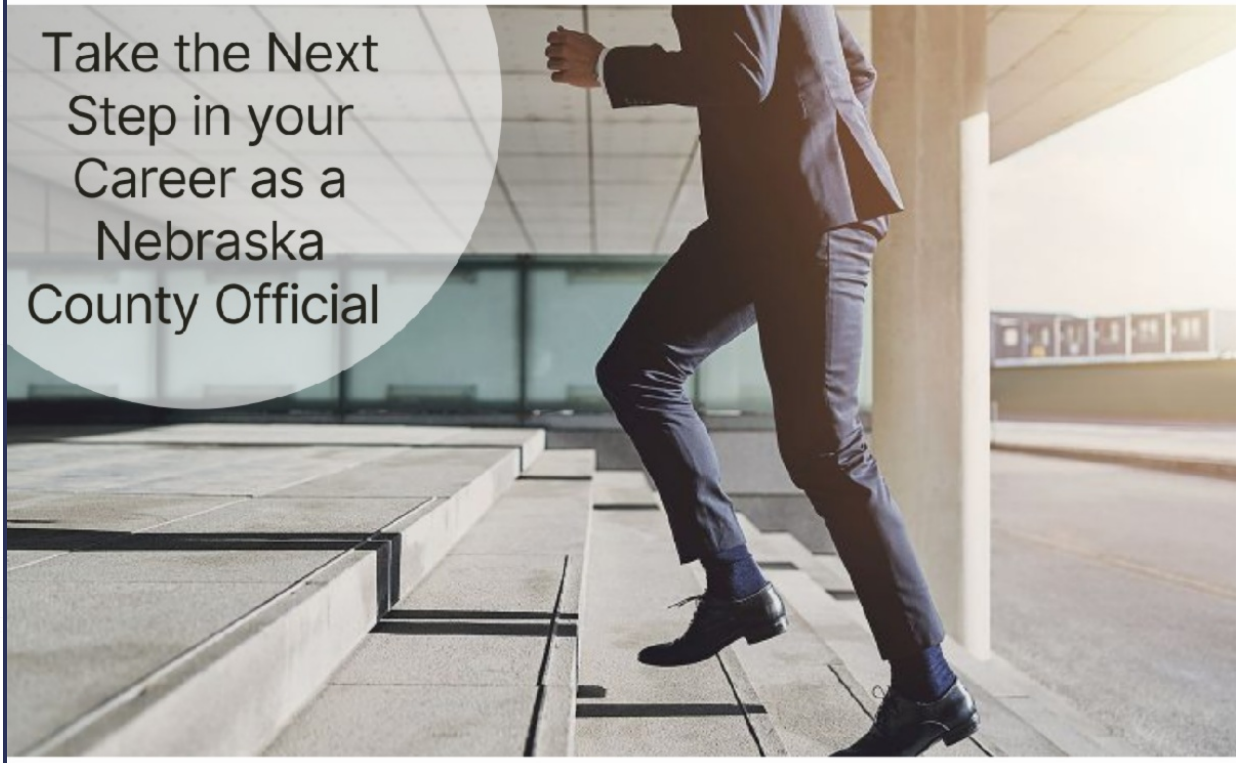
